The world is becoming more African, and Africa has some of the fastest-growing economies. 60% of Africa's population comprises of youths, and this is projected to increase by 50% in 2050, making it home to the youngest population in the world (the perfect gaming audience).

In a bid to transition from a consumer market to a creator economy, we have about 100 indie game studios across the continent, building games and working tirelessly to build an industry in our society, but very little is known of them. 






EXPO & CREATIVE BLOC CARNIVAL SEPT 30, 2023






